Help restore timely diagnoses at Our Hospital


When someone in our community undergoes a biopsy, they are waiting for answers that can change everything. Those answers begin in our hospital laboratory.

This essential equipment prepares biopsy and tissue samples so they can be examined under a microscope to detect cancer and other serious diseases. **This critical tool is used in every procedure to test for cancer.**

With only one machine remaining, our lab team has lost the built-in backup they rely on to ensure accuracy, efficiency, and continuity of care.

The cost is \$100,000.
